



CAMP MISAWANNEE COUNSELLOR IN TRAINING (CIT)

Description

Time Commitment

The role of a Counsellor in Training would require 1 to 3 hours each month from May to July, and during camp would require 10 to 14 hours per day.

Duties and Responsibilities

CIT staff work directly with their cabin Counsellors to provide a safe and meaningful camp experience to their campers. Report to Head Counsellor Director.

May - July:

- Staff Social and bonding event - 4-5 hours
- Connect with their assigned Counsellor - discuss plans for their cabins and share ideas
- Collaborate with Counsellor and work with fellow cabin staff to plan icebreakers, cabin morale-building activities
- Prepare talks to be given to campers during camp

During camp:

- During staff training days, prepare cabin area for campers, prepare icebreakers and welcome activities
- Help campers unpack and get settled in
- Supervise a cabin of up to 6 campers, assist them at meals and wakeup/bedtime (not applicable to daycamps)
- Promote good cabin morale; identify points of friction and assist conflict resolution if needed
- Participate in camp activities with campers
- Give a talk on an area of personal growth
- Provide supervision on camper trips
- Ensure cabin and camper areas are kept neat and clean
- Help campers pack and get going at the end of camp
